



Situate in Chanceford Township in the County of York, Containing as above set forth 41 1/2 & 157 1/2 Acres and allowance &c. Surveyed by John Forsyth late D. S. on the 20th day of November A. D. 1799. In Pursuance of a Warrant for 60^{1/2} (directed to be surveyed in two pieces) bearing date the 16th day of April 1787. Resurveyed by the old lines on the 19th day of June A. D. 1810, at the request of the owner George Bershinger, who desired the same to be returned for confirmation.
