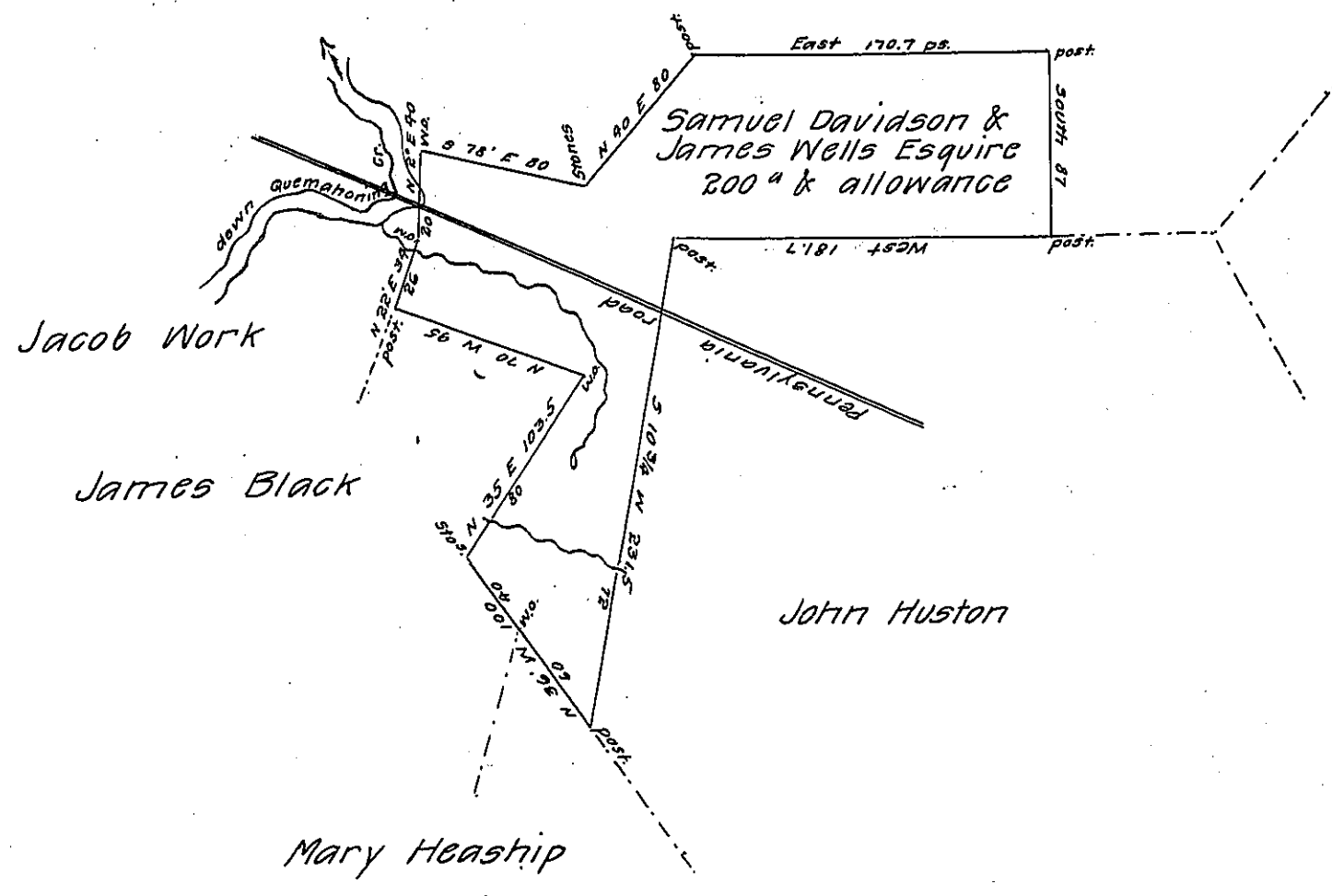


Vacant Rocks.

S. as appears by his official Draught remaining in my office on the 15th day of July 1800 in pursuance of warrant Granted to Samuel Davidson & James Wells Esqr. dated the 19th day of May 1792. And certified the 23^d day of November 1811.
