



A Draught of an Island situate in the river Susquehanna, in the township of Manor in the county of Lancaster, called white grape Island, about one hundred yards west of Bottomsee Island and about two perches south of Dove Island containing one acre & nine perches neat measure, Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated 26th of March Anno Domini 1823. Granted to Christian Mellinger, Examined & Certified the 3^d May 1830.
