



A draft of a tract of land called Sugar Bottom situate on the East side of Lycorming in Muncy township in Northumberland County surveyed the Seventeenth day of July 1786, in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Webb dated the twenty Fourth day of June 1773, containing three Hundred and Eight acres and half an Acre, with the usual Allowance of six per Cent for roads &c.
