Baird the Above tract of Land Situate on a Small Stream that empties on the East Side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna — About two Miles and a half below the State Line and About one Mile Above Tioga in Luzerne County Containing three hundred & four Acres and forty one perches and Allowance of Six & Cent.
