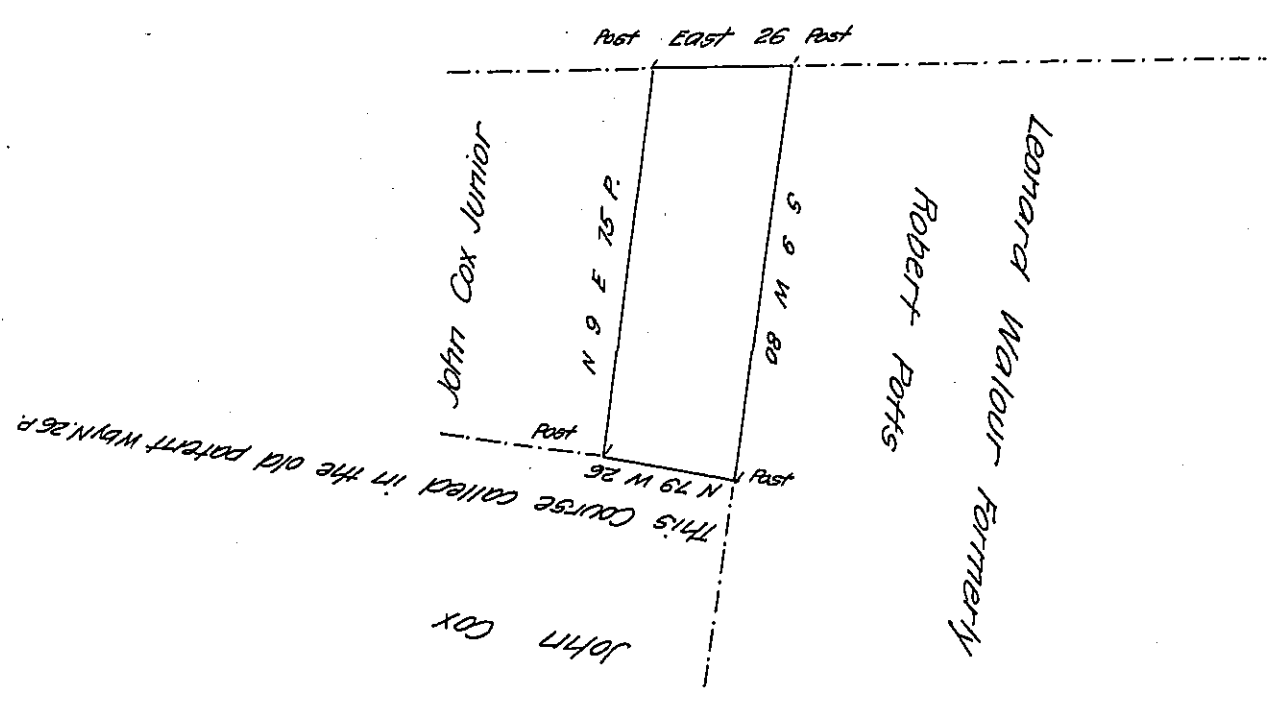


Hugh Montgomery

N. B. the above tract of land is comprehended in a survey made by Bartram Galbraith D.S. the second day of August 1765 and returned into the Surveyor
 Generals Office for Robert Potts on a Warrant dated the 15th day of October 1744
 for which a Patent was granted unto the said Robert Potts dated the 28th day
 of June 1768 and now Claimed Title by Leonard Wallour
