



The dotted line and that part of the above diagram embracing the letters A. B. C. D. & E. represents a Survey made to Jeremiah Warder Jun<sup>r</sup> on the 15<sup>th</sup> of February 1828 a return whereof is herewith enclosed. You will perceive that the dates of the interfering Surveys are inserted in the drafts respectively also the date of the War<sup>r</sup> or Location upon which they were made. The Survey made for Jeremiah Warder Jun<sup>r</sup> is occupied by Daniel Smith Jun<sup>r</sup> and William Fair who claim under the title of John McKenzie. Thomas Bell claims that part of the Survey of Jeremiah Warder Jun<sup>r</sup> included within the Survey in his own name and is occupied by him
