



Situate in the fifth Donation District Mercer County Sandycreek Township, on the waters of Sandycreek containing one hundred and sixty-one Acres and one hundred and six perches & Allowance of six per cent. for Roads & C^r surveyed for — McCormick in pursuence of his Actual Settlement and Improvement made thereon he claiming it as vacant or unappropriated land surveyed September 9th 1842

N.B. It is proper for me to inform you that if this is vacant Land there will not be left for Lot No 872 more than 22 Acres. Some extreme blunder in the Original Surveying appears to have been made on the ground— John Findley D.S.
