



The above is a draft of Donation lot N^o 824 in the General draft of the fourth Donation district which appears to be an un-drawn tract. Surveyed by me the 15th day of August 1828. according to the original lines and corners on the ground. Contain^{ing} two hundred and two acres and 80 perches and allowance of six per cent. for Roads. Surveyed in pursuance of the actual settlement and residence of Jared Hill. On this tract there were two families residing at the time of surveying, each having large improvements thereon.
