


A draught of a tract situate in the Township of Wyalusing in the County of Bradford. Containing three hundred and one acres and three-fourths of an acre and allowance of six per cent. for roads. Originally surveyed to Nicholas Rittenhouse on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of October 1775 by Charles Stewart late Deputy Surveyor in pursuance of a warrant dated the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 1774, as appears by his Draught of survey in my possession - the lines were examined by me on the fifteenth day of February 1819 - and certified by
