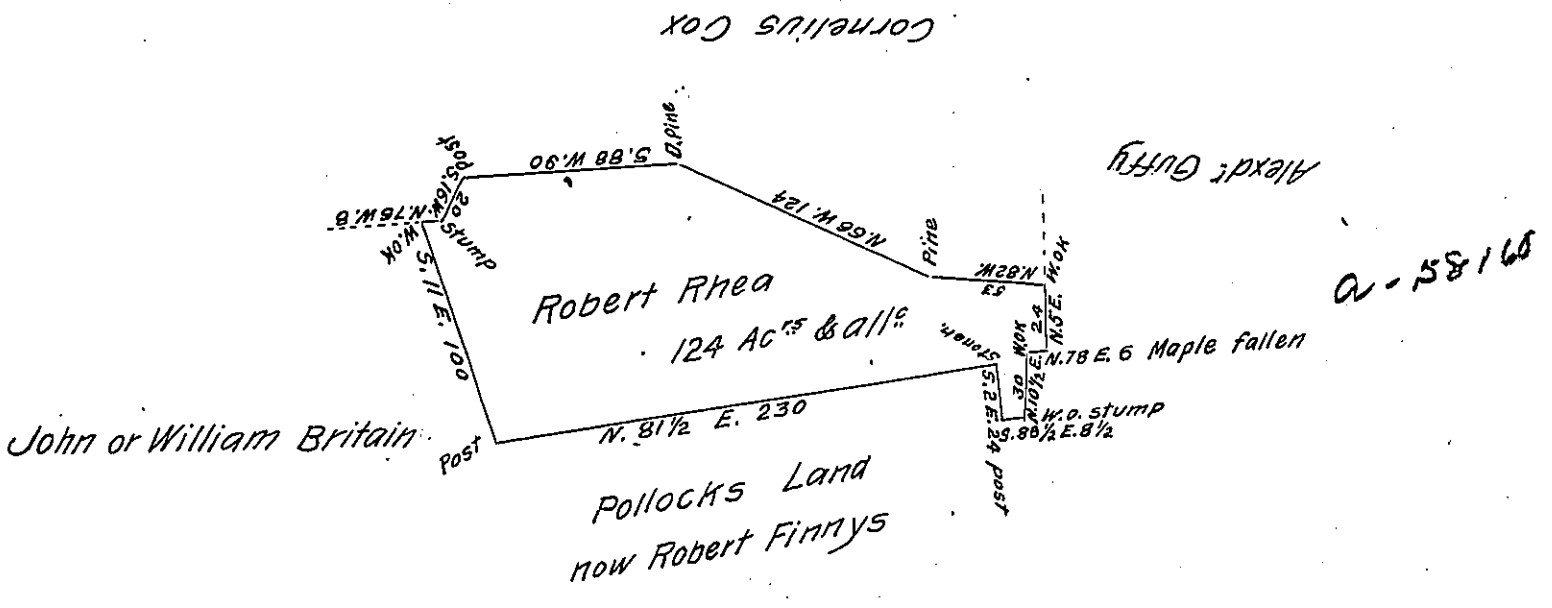

By virtue of a warrant dated 16<sup>th</sup> day of November 1784 surveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> of June 1798 by Henry Donnell the Deputy unto Robt Rhea the above described Tract of one hundred & twenty-four acres of land & allowance situated near the Warrior Run adjoining lands of Cornelius Cox surveyed in right of Joseph Bull and others in Turbit Township North<sup>bd</sup> County and examined and certify'd this 28<sup>th</sup> of May 1804.
