



A Draught of a Tract of land situate in Nippenose Township now
 Lycoming County Survey'd by order of Joseph J. Wallis by James Law
 the 6th day of June 1795 for Christian Stake & Cleary Cambel in pur-
 suance of their Warrant bearing date the 24th day of November 1786.

The owner of the land finding that Joseph J. Wallis had by some
 means neglected to return the said survey, applied to me to return
 it, and on examining the lines the 19th day of February 1810. I find
 them mark'd all round, and the tract to contain one hundred and
 sixty-eight acres & allowance of six pr. Cent. for roads & C.
