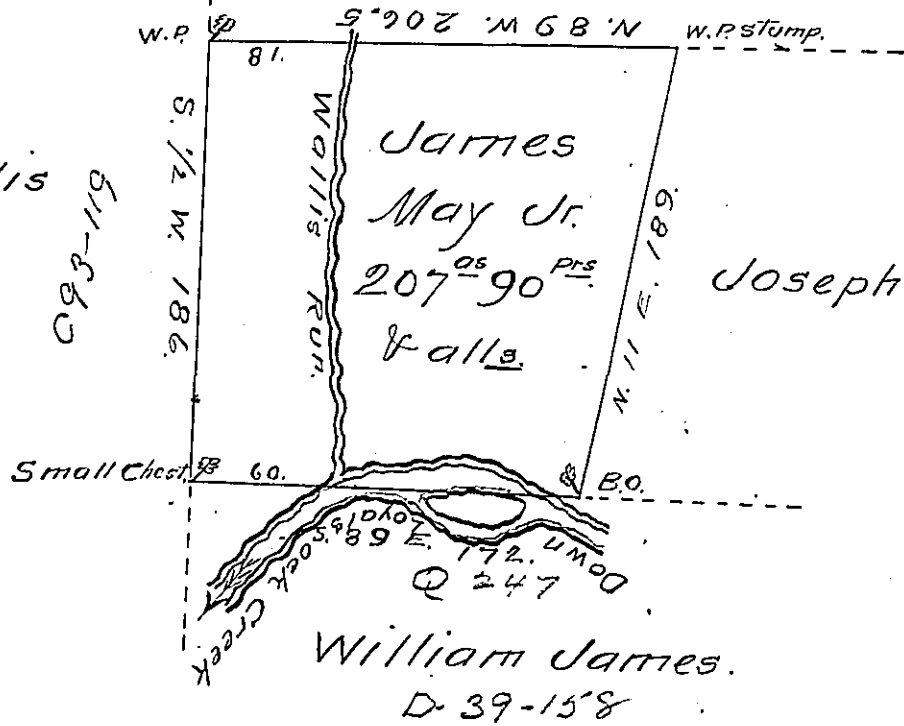

SITUATE in Hepburn Township Lycoming County formerly Loyalsock Township Northumberland County including Wallis Run about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile above the Loyalsock Narrows and bounded as above described - Surveyed to James May Junr. on the 23^d. day of March 1840 by virtue of his warrant for 400 acres bearing date the 10th day of April 1793 Containing two hundred and seven acres and ninety perches with allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c.
