This tract and another were survey'd in 1683 to John Priestner, the other tract is returned to W. Rattew for 115 acres ( See the Draught of Ashton ). The Warrant was granted to Tho Cartwright for both tracts & he in his life time sold this tract ( by word of mouth ) to Jo<sup>r</sup> Dutton & Dutton to Neal. — Neal hath lived on it some years.
