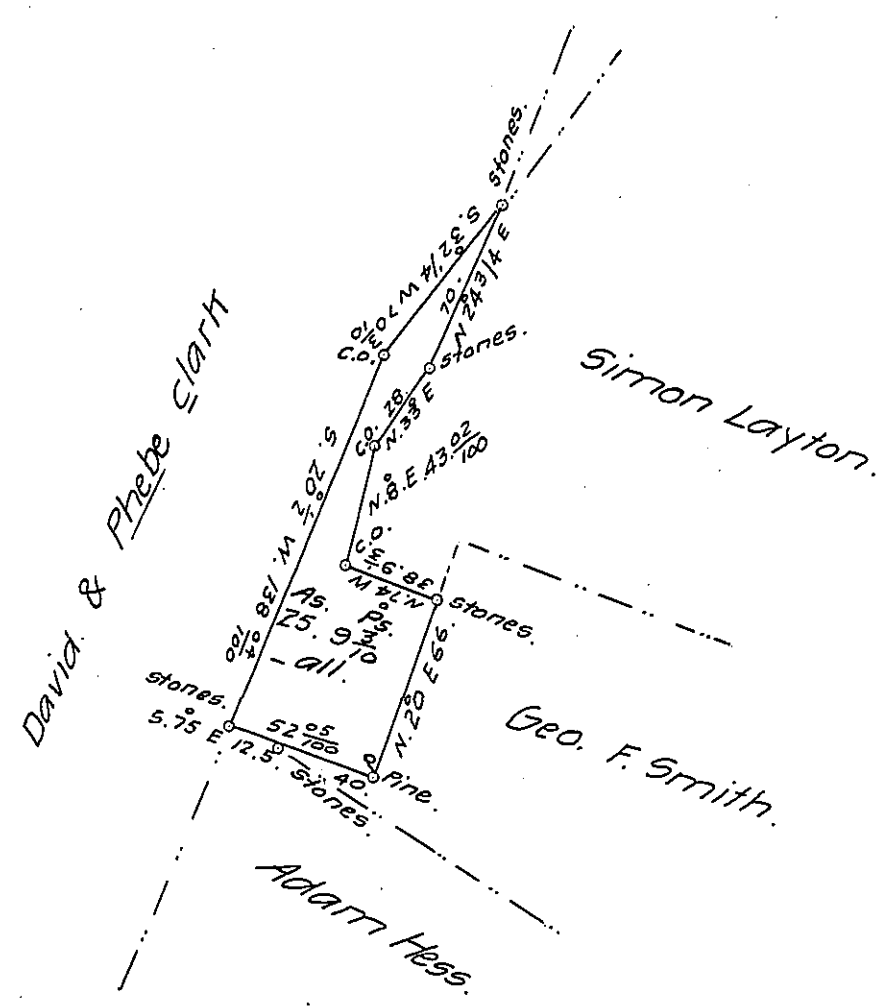

Surveyed 10th day of March A.D. 1854 by Job Garland Esq then Dept Surveyor (on no warrant) and resurveyed in part and carefully examined by me 28th September A.D. 1887 in pursuance of warrant granted to Job Truax and G. H. N. Garland and Job Truax, by assignment conveyed his interest to and in the land 30th day September A.D. 1886 to G. H. N. Garland.
