



These may certify that by the Commissions order and the consent of Joseph Sharplis I surveyed for ye Proprietaries use ninety acres of overplus land, of a Tract of Land situate in Middle Town in Chester County. Now in ye possession of ye said Joseph Sharp-
lis leaving the sd Joseph Sharplis his 300 acres of land with the allowance of ten acres for every hundred according to law.
