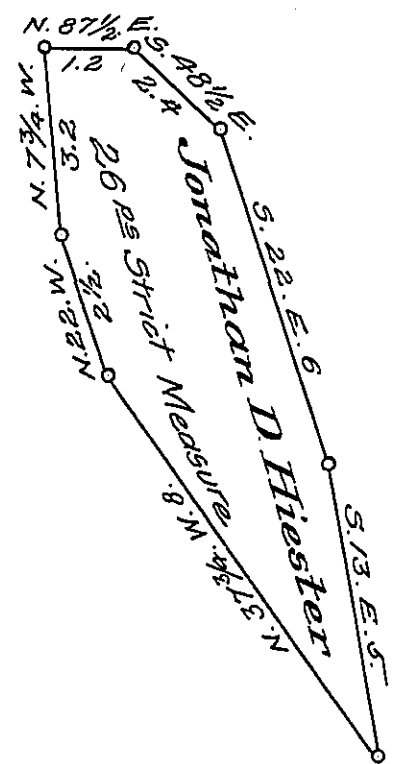

A Draught of an Island Situate in the river Susquehanna Called Duck Island about fifty or sixty perches below Turkey Island and between Dritts Island and Oldweilers Island opposite the land of Jacob Shock Ju^s on the Lancaster shore and opposite the land of Jacob Bay Miller on the York shore Situate in Manor Township Lancaster County Containing twenty six perches strict Measure Surveyed the 6th day of November 1816. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 21st of May A.D. 1816 granted to Jonathan D. Hiester
