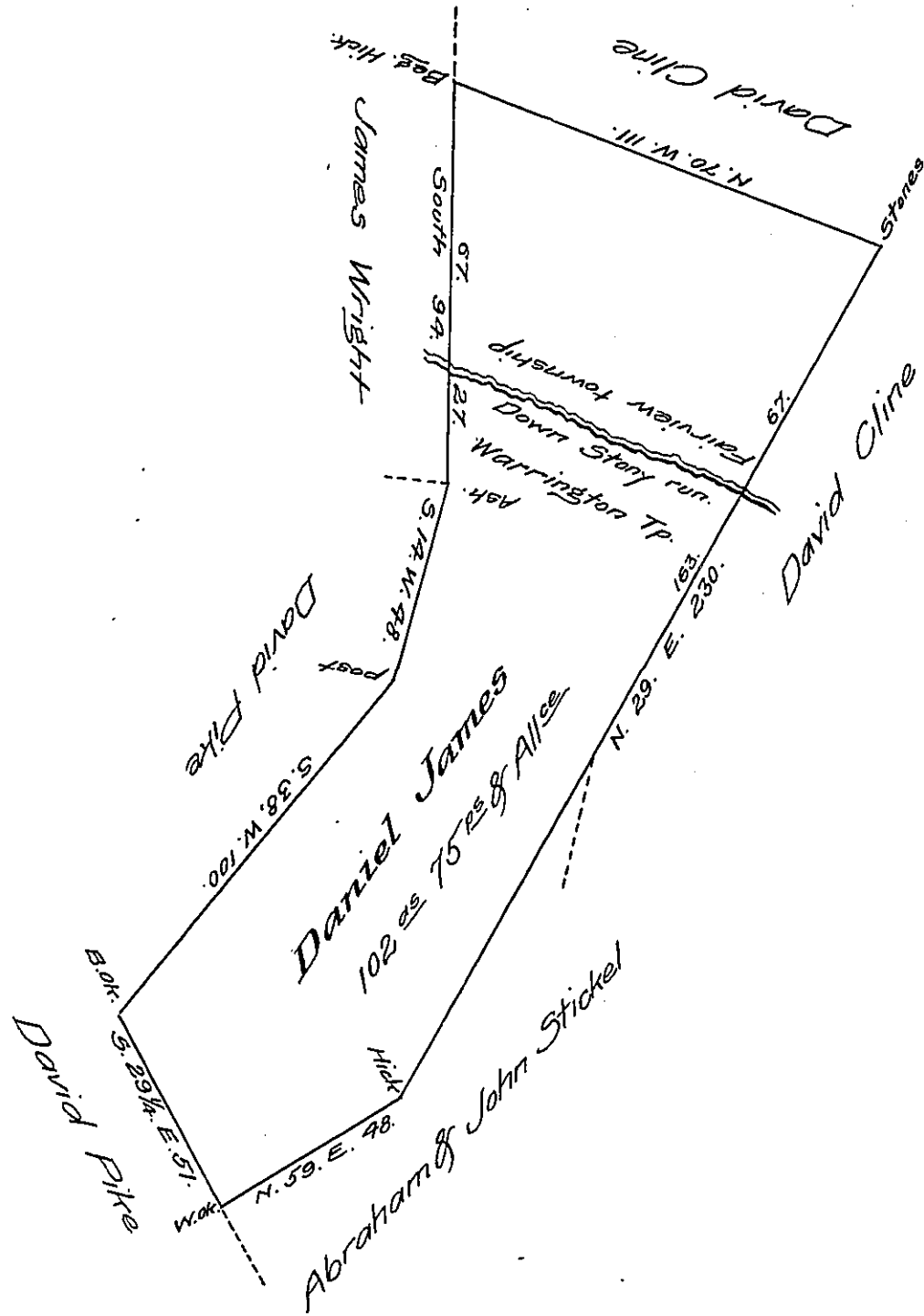

Situate partly in Fairview (late Newbury) Township and partly in Warrington township York County Containing One hundred and two acres seventy five perches and allowance— Surveyed the 5th day of February 1750 by George Stevenson Esqr. then D.S. in pursuance of a Warrant for 25^{ac} granted to Daniel James dated the 26th day of February 1745— and now at the request of Abraham & John Stickle examined calculated and returned for confirmation 27th October 1829.
