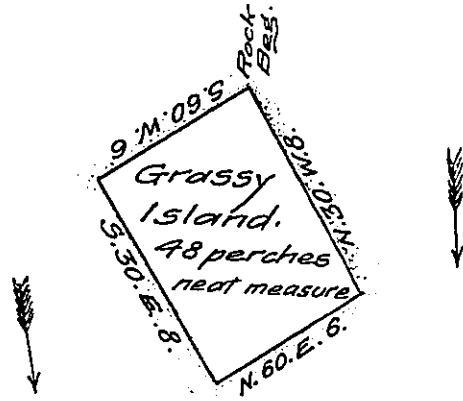


Stephen J. Cooper's land
