The above Draught represents a tract of Land in Martic township, Lancaster County, containing 45 a. & 138 perches with the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c; part of 87 a. & 144 p. Surveyed to George Sides & Peter Young August 31st 1819 in pursuance of a Warrant dated April 3rd 1786 granted to John Caldwell. Surveyed the above part for the heirs of Jacob Sides Dec^d September 6th 1865.
