



The above Draught represents a lot of land in Martic township Lancaster County Containing 11 Acres & 64 perches, and the usual Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. 8 acres 47 p^s & the allowance aforesaid, being part of 165 acres & Allowance aforesaid, Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated December 20th 1750, granted to James Clark. The remaining 3 acres & 17 perches & allowance being part of 23 a^s & 60 p^s & All^s Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant dated June 13th 1770, granted to James Caldwell. Surveyed the above part for Amos Walton, February 24th 1859.
