

on the 18th February 1830 by virtue of his warrant dated the 19th January 1830
Containing two hundred and forty two acres and the usual allowance.

This Survey may possibly interfere on its Southern boundey with Survys made for
the Asylum Company but of this I am not certain not having found any lines on
the ground.

This survey was re-examined in June last, under my direction, at the request of
Hugh Bellas Esq? and found clear of all interferences. Witness my hand July 7th
1834.
