

1802 for Samuel Carpenter & William Collin by Virtue of their Warrant bearing  
date on the 24 day of April 1795 including their improvement said to be made  
on the 4 day of April 1792. Containing four hundred four Acres and eighty four  
Perches with the usual Allowance of Six P Cent for Roads &c.
