Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1794, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Andrew Henderson, dated February 20<sup>th</sup> 1793, & resurveyed and the <sup>part</sup> which was in older surveys struck off on April the 19<sup>th</sup> 1817, & returned agreeable to an order of resurvey dated April 3<sup>rd</sup> 1817, granted to John Metz & George Runy.
