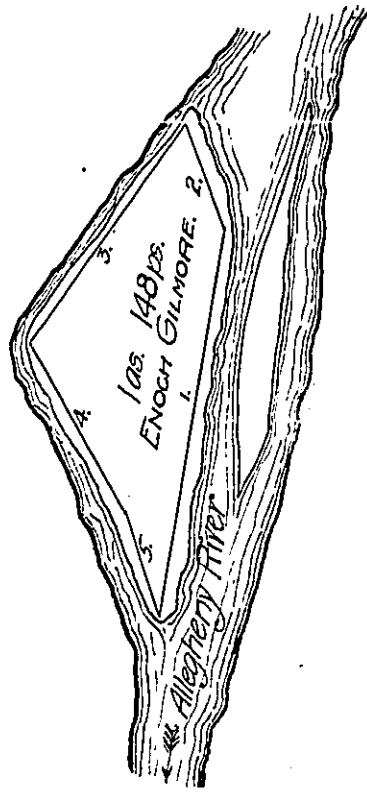


*Courses Found the Island

Containing one acre one hundred forty eight perches. Surveyed on Warrent granted to Enoch Gilmore dated 4th. of August A.D. 1831, 12th August, 1831.
