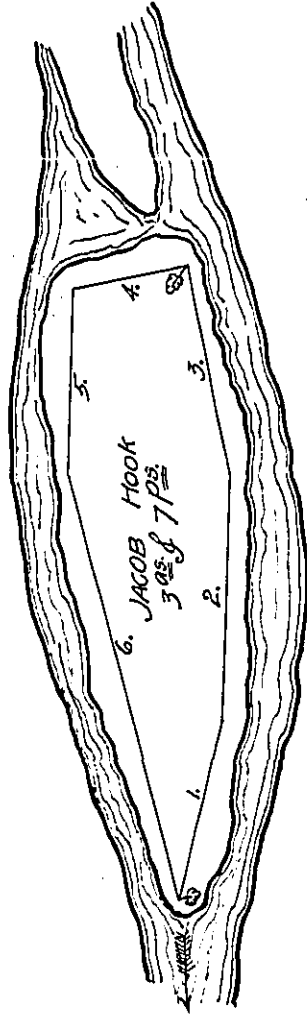


Corses Found the Island

Draft of an Island in the Allegheny River, Situate in Kirzua Township, Warren County, below a place called Hazelton Barr and below an Island and opposite one surveyed to Jacob Hook and about twenty perches above a House of said Hook on the West side of and near the West Shore of said River, CONTAINING three acres and seven perches neat measure. Surveyed the 5th Day of March, 1829, on a Warrant granted to Jacob Hook, for one acre & one hundred and fifty perches. Dated 13th January, 1829.
