



Courses and distances, Beginning at a post the South East corner of land surveyed for Robert Falconer, Esq., and run North 390 perches $\frac{1}{10}$ to Post. Thence East 283 perches $\frac{7}{10}$ to Maple. S. 36° W. 483 " $\frac{7}{10}$ to Begin.

Draft of a tract of land situate in Deerfield Township, Warren County, and west of the Allegheny River. Containing Three Hundred and twenty six Acres and 84 perches and allowance. Unimproved. Surveyed 26th September, A.D. 1836, for N.A. Lowry on a Warrant granted to said N. A. Lowry, dated 4th of August, A.D. 1836.
