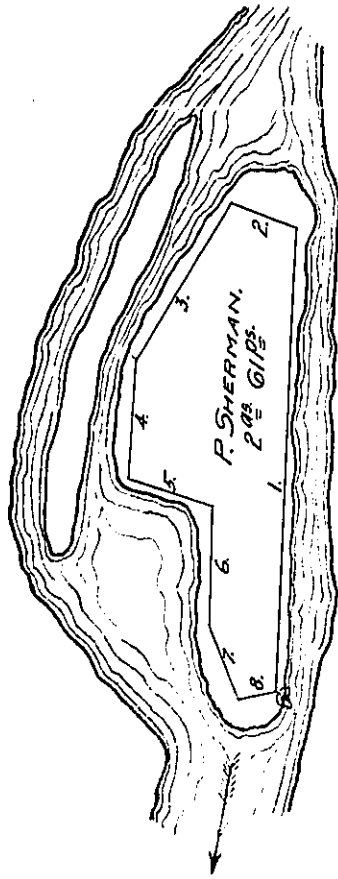

Surveyed the ___ Day of April A.D. 1829.
