Beginning at the North West Corner of Warrant Number 1799, thence 531/2°W. 164 rods to a post thence 5.861/2° E. 105 rods to a post, thence N31/2° E. 164 rods to a post in the North line of Said Warrant thence N861/2° W. 105 rods to the place of beginning.

A draft of atract of land situated in the township of Highland and County of EIK Containing 101 acres and 85'14 perches and allowance of Six percent for roads &c. Surveyed for H.O.EIIIthorpe, D.C. Oyster, Alfred Short, C.R.Earley Horace Little and H.M. Powers the 8th day of October 1885 it being a part of a larger tract of 1004 acres and allowance originally Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas M. Willing dated August 18" 1792 John Wainwright , C.S.
