



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Twenty ninth day of January 1733 Surveyed unto Jacob Acker a tract of Land situate in Oley in y^e County of Philada. Begining at a post thence by vacant Land North fifty Degrees West one hundred and sixty perches to a post thence by vacant Land South forty Degrees West one hundred and six perches to a post thence by vacant — south fifty Degrees East one hundred & sixty perches to a Hickory thence by Vacant Land North forty Degrees East one hundred and six perches to y^e Place of Begining Containing one hundred Acres with the Usual allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent.
