

Pursuant to a warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 7th day of November Anno. Dom. 1755 Granted to George Ashbridge for the Surveying of 649 of Land in any part of the Province of Pennsylvania not appropriated and Purchased of the Indians The above Described Tract of Land (as part of the said Sixty four acres) was surveyed the 13th. day of the 3rd mo. 1771. Which according to the Present Position of the Needle is bounded as follows (Viz) Begining at a Stone at a Corner of John Cloyds Land in a line of Joseph Lewis's Land Thence Extending by the Said Land of the said John Cloyd South 87/12 E. 108 P. to a Stake Thence by the same Land North 65d East 60 pches. to a Stake Thence by Vacant Land North 16d West 8112 Tpches. to a neap of Stones in another line of Joseph Lewis's Land Thence by the same 576112 West 16414 pches to the Place of begining Situate in the Township of Tredyffrin in Chester County Containing 11:68 the allowance of Six of. Cent. & Thomas Lightfoot, Dp+y. Surveyor.
