Whereas Joseph England of the Township of West Nottingham of the County of Chester, Yeoman, hath requested that we would grant him our Warrant to Resurvey a certain Tract of Land situate on the South side of North East River in the said Township of Nottingham and county aforesaid for (obliged) Surveyed for five hundred Acres to William Brown, late of the said Township Miller the Right whereto is now by Sundry Meane Conveyances vested in him the said Joseph England. These are to Authorize and Require you to Resurvey or cause to be Resurveyed the said Tract of Land according to the first Lines, and Bounds of the same and of the adjoining Lands, and make Return thereof, into our Secretary's Office for the use of the said Joseph England and in so doing this shall be your sufficient Warrt Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Land Office by virtue of certain powers from ye said Proprietaries at Philad^a This 12th of November 1747.
