In Pursuance of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the tenth day of March 1732 Surveyed unto Elisha Girdhal of Nottingham in the County of Chester a certain parcel of land called Mount Rocky, lying among the borders to the northward of Nottingham aforesaid beginning at a corner white oak sapling and extending thence North East two hundred and twenty perches to a Chesnut marked thence North<sup>ly</sup> west by West one hundred and twelve perches to a Chesnut tree thence west by North one hundred and ten perches to a white oak thence South by west two hundred and twenty perches to a black oak in Jacob Seal's Line thence East by South ninety ---- perches to the place of beginning containing two hundred and sixteen acres. Surveyed in the year 1732.
