By vertue of a warrant from the Commissioners bearing date the 16th of the 12th month 1701. There was Surveyd on the sixth day of the second month 1702 unto George Harland two hundred acres of land in a Bend of Brandiwine Creek in the Township of Bromingham in the County of Chester for which he has agreed to pay fifty pounds to the use of the Proprietary Beginning at a Poplar at a corner of Philip Romans land and by the side of Brandiwine Creek, ^{then up the same} on Several Courses five hundred and eleven $\frac{1}{2}$ ches to the mouth of a Run Then up the same on ~~Several~~ ^{Several} Courses one hundred sixty seven $\frac{1}{2}$ ches to a white oak by the said Run Then by the said Romans Land north Eighty degrees west One hundred forty seven $\frac{1}{2}$ ches to the Beginning.
