Jackson & the Bakers by Deed of ye 21st January 1700 Granted this Land unto Samuel Bishop & John Broomall, their heirs & Assigns The sd 200 acres were in the year 1703, Resurveyed & divided between Bishop & Broomall, and on the 12th of Apr 1718, Bishop, Released 100^{ac} of sd 200^{ac} unto sd John Broomall, his heirs & assigns, Broomall Sold About 80^{ac} of sd 100^{ac} to David Register and died, since whose decease Daniel, the heir at Law of sd John has Released sd 80^{ac} to sd Register who desires a Pat. for ye Same, but if this can't be obtained ~~then~~ then a Confirmation of ye 100^{ac} according to ye Resurvey, ^{& Division} which (unless mislaid) will be found in ye Gen^l Surv^r office. My Father Resurvey'd it and I have a duplicate of his return
