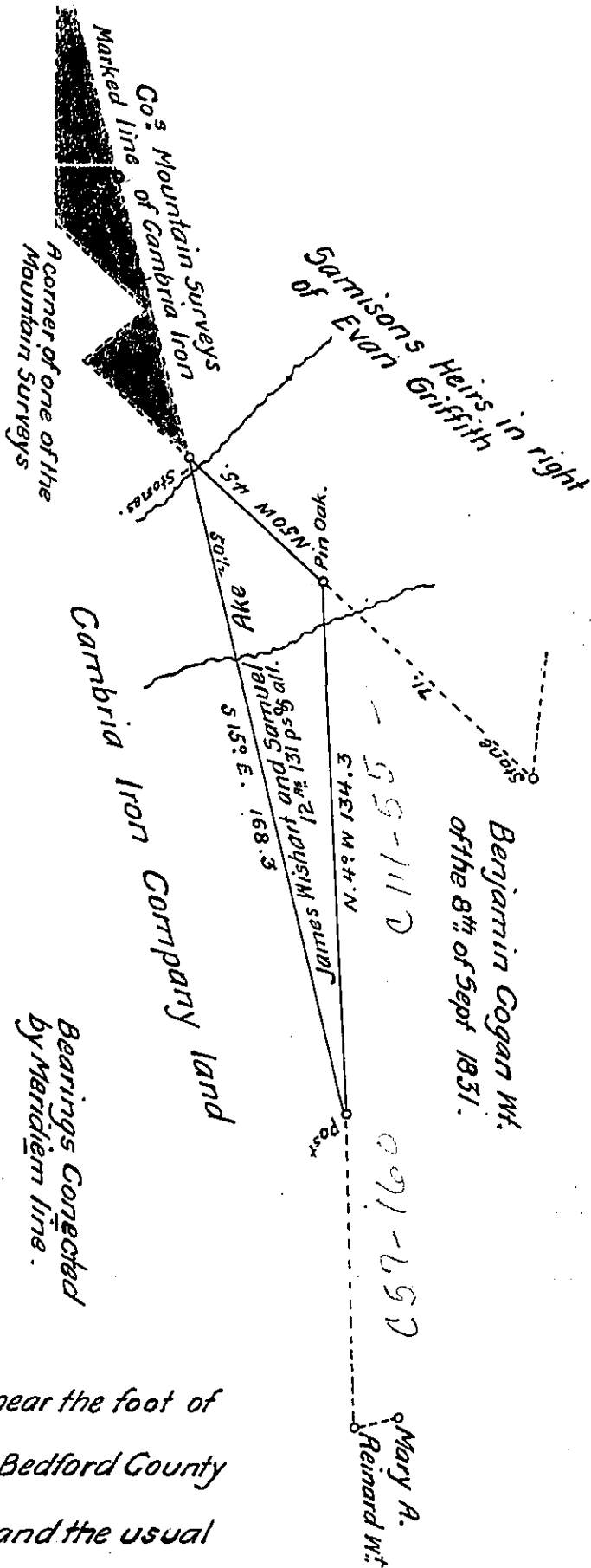


The red represents an interference of Evan Griffith with the mountain survey as marked upon the ground.
