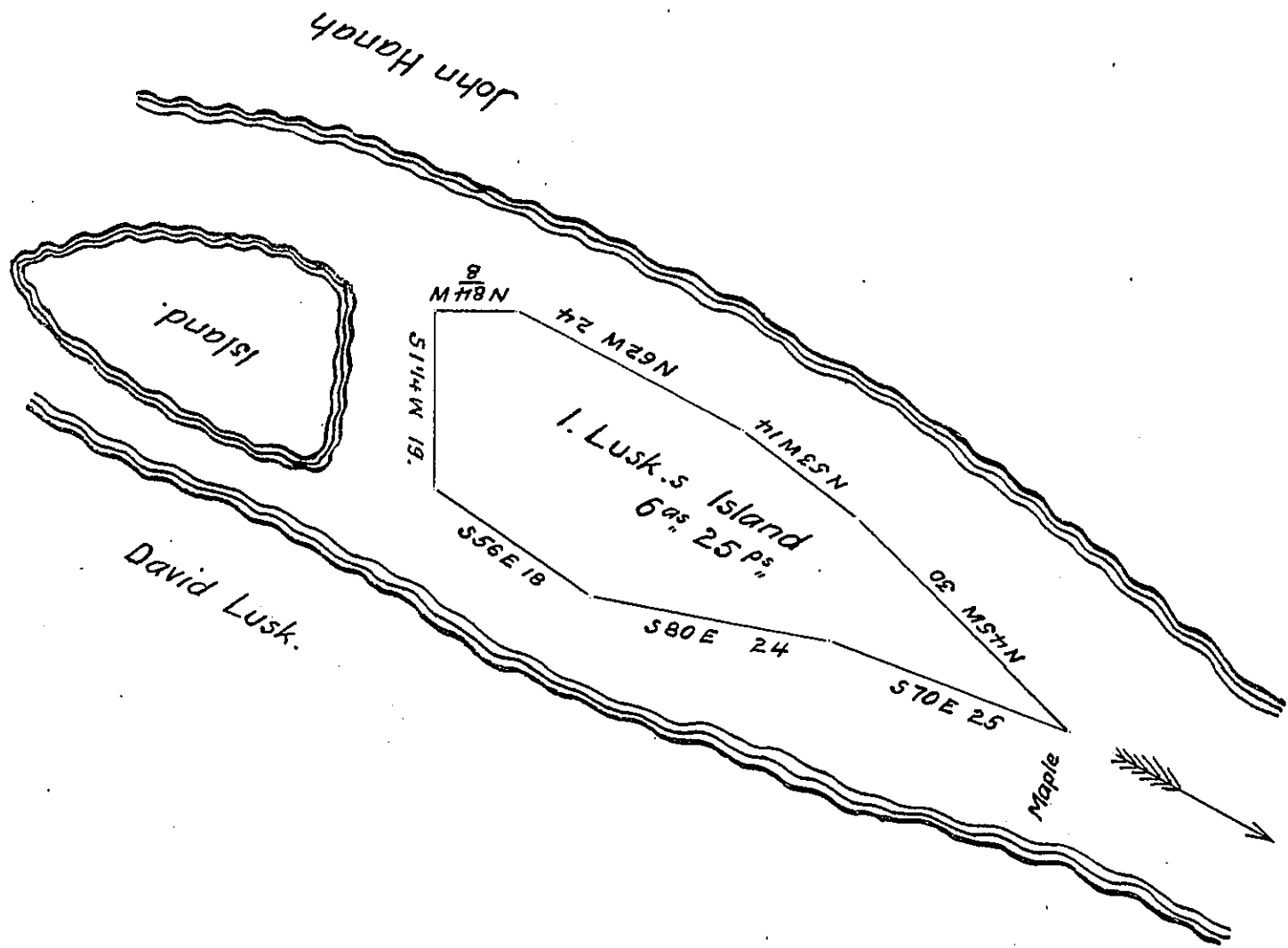


FORM NO. 1.



Surveyed the above described Island on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of June 1815 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Isaac Lusk dated the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1815. Containing Six Acres & twenty five perches strict measure situate near the middle of the West Branch of the Susquehanna, about two miles above the upper end of the Great Island & immediately below Lusks upper Island. The farm of David Lusk in Bald Eagle Township on the South & the farm of John Hanah on the North in Dunstable Township. Known by the Name of Lusk's or Hanah's Island in Lycorning County Unimproved
