Draught of a Tract or parcel of Land situate part in Fannet & part in Metal Townships Franklin County containing thirty four Acres one hundred and fifty six perches and allowance of six per cent for Roads &c being part of 76 Acres 91 perches and allowance Resurveyed 20th August 1791. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Alexander, John, and James Potts bearing date 17 September 1784, Resurveyed the above part 30th Oct. 1829. including the piece marked A, first included in the original Survey in dispute with Hugh McGurdy on his Application N^o 2581. which part marked A. at a meeting of the Board of Property on the 1st August 1791 was confirmed to said McGurdy; But subsequently, was given to Alexander Potts by the verdict of a Jury of said County. & said Potts now desires a return of Survey including the same to be accepted in order for further confirmation by Patent. - See a new return on McGurdys Application leaving out the said piece of Land.
