Draft of Evans Griqqs' Island No. 1. Situate in Great Bend Township Susquehanna County in the Susquehanna River about 1 1/2 miles below Great Bend Depot of the "Erie Railway" and about 1/2 mile above the New York State line, and lying adjacent & opposite said Griqqs' Island No. 2, and his Farm on the Northeast Shore of the River. Surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October A.D. 1866. for Evans Griqqs in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October A.D. 1866. Containing three Acres and ninety nine perches Strict measure, nearly one half of which has been for probably 20 years improved by him & his predecessor.
