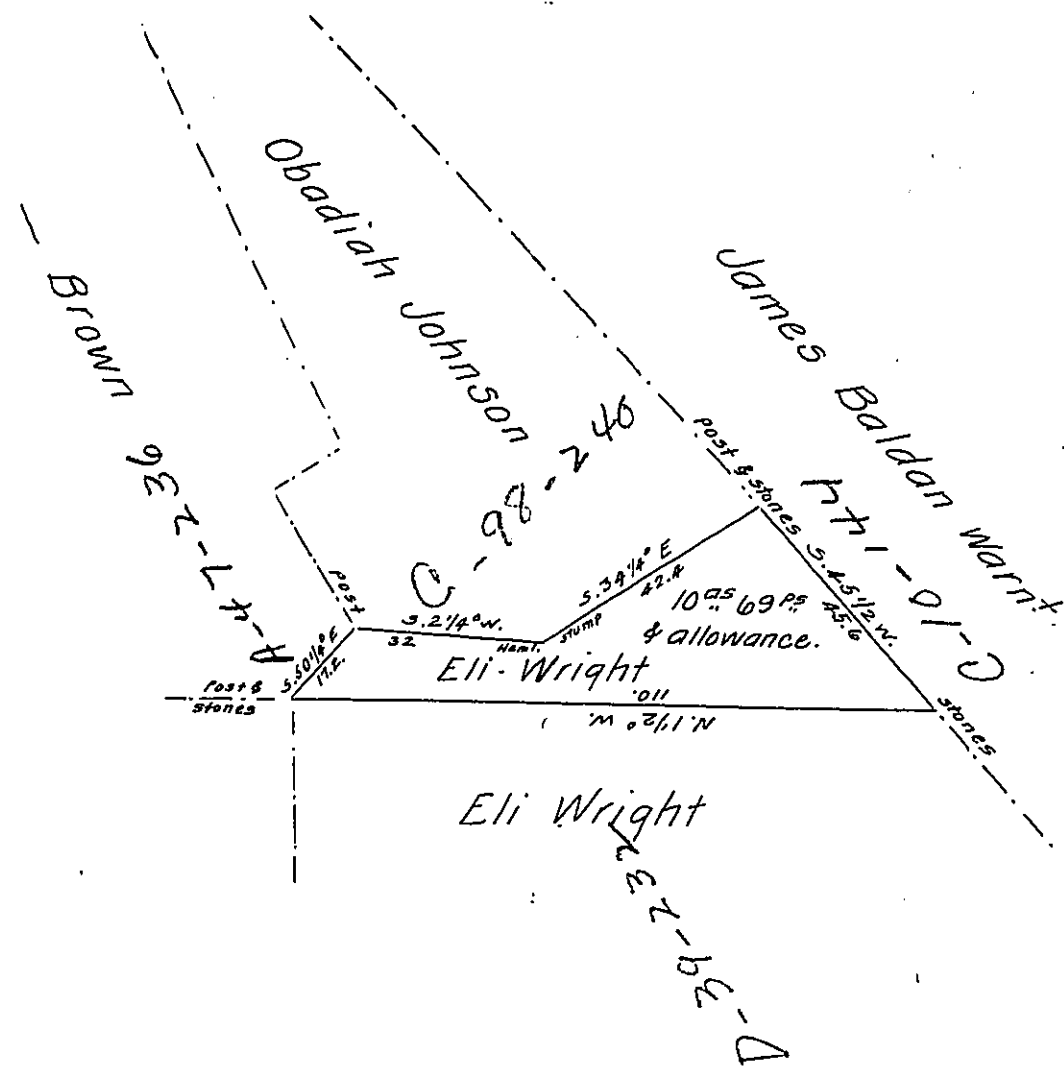


FORM NO. 1.



A Draft of a tract of land Situate in Lenox township Susquehanna County adjoining lands of Obadiah Johnson on the East. lands late of James Baldan on the South. Eli Wright on the West. And land now in possession of one Brown on the North. Surveyed the sixth day of September A. D. 1854. Which is accepted and approved by me in pursuance of an improvement Warrant in the name of Eli Wright. bearing date the twenty ninth day of February A. D. 1856. Containing ten acres and Sixty nine perches. And the allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c.

Containing an improvement of about two Acres. Commenced about the 1st March 1840.

I think upon investigation this land would be found Covered with a Warrant in the Name of John Nicholson
