Note. The above described tract of land is improved and in possession of Bennett Randall & Co. John Purvis and Philander Niles; the owners of the Strawbridge Warrant, having sold to the first settlers, the land as far West, as the resurvey line of the Strawbridge Warrant, before the old original western boundary line of No 283 had been found. Along the eastern boundary line of the James Kimball Warrant, the old original Strawbridge line is still to be found; but North of said Warrant, the land having been cleared many years ago, the old landmarks are all destroyed.
