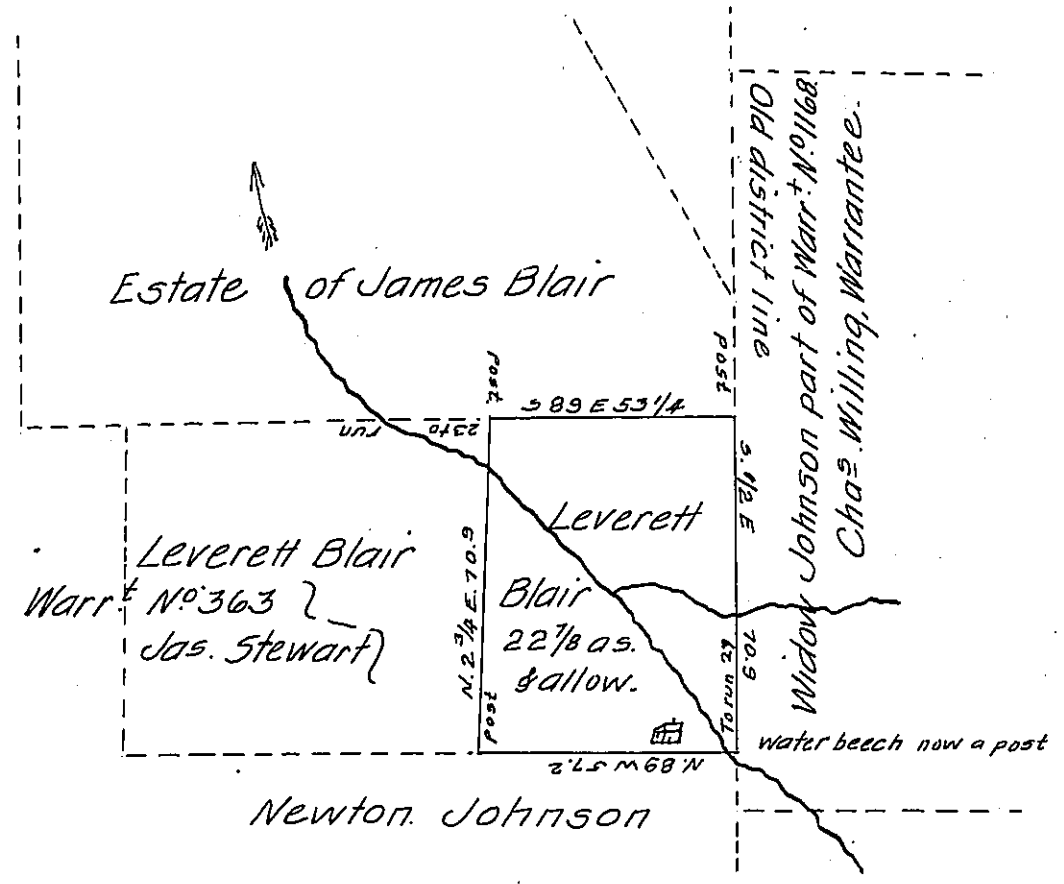


FORM NO 1.



The draft of a tract of land, (improved since Jan. 1st 1851.) Surveyed for Leverett Blair on the 13th of August 1868. in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 5th of June 1868. Containing twenty two acres and seven eights of an acre, and the allowance of 6 per Cent for roads. Adjoining an old line, that was run to divide McCay's and Edmiston's district. Situate in Delmar township, Tioga Co.

The above surveyed tract of land has heretofore been considered as being a part of Warrant No. 363, James Stewart, Warrantee and was purchased as such by the said Leverett Blair. Some doubt has lately arisen, as to whether the Warr. No. 363, did extend East far enough to adjoin the district line which has induced the said Leverett Blair to apply for the above mentioned Warrant.
