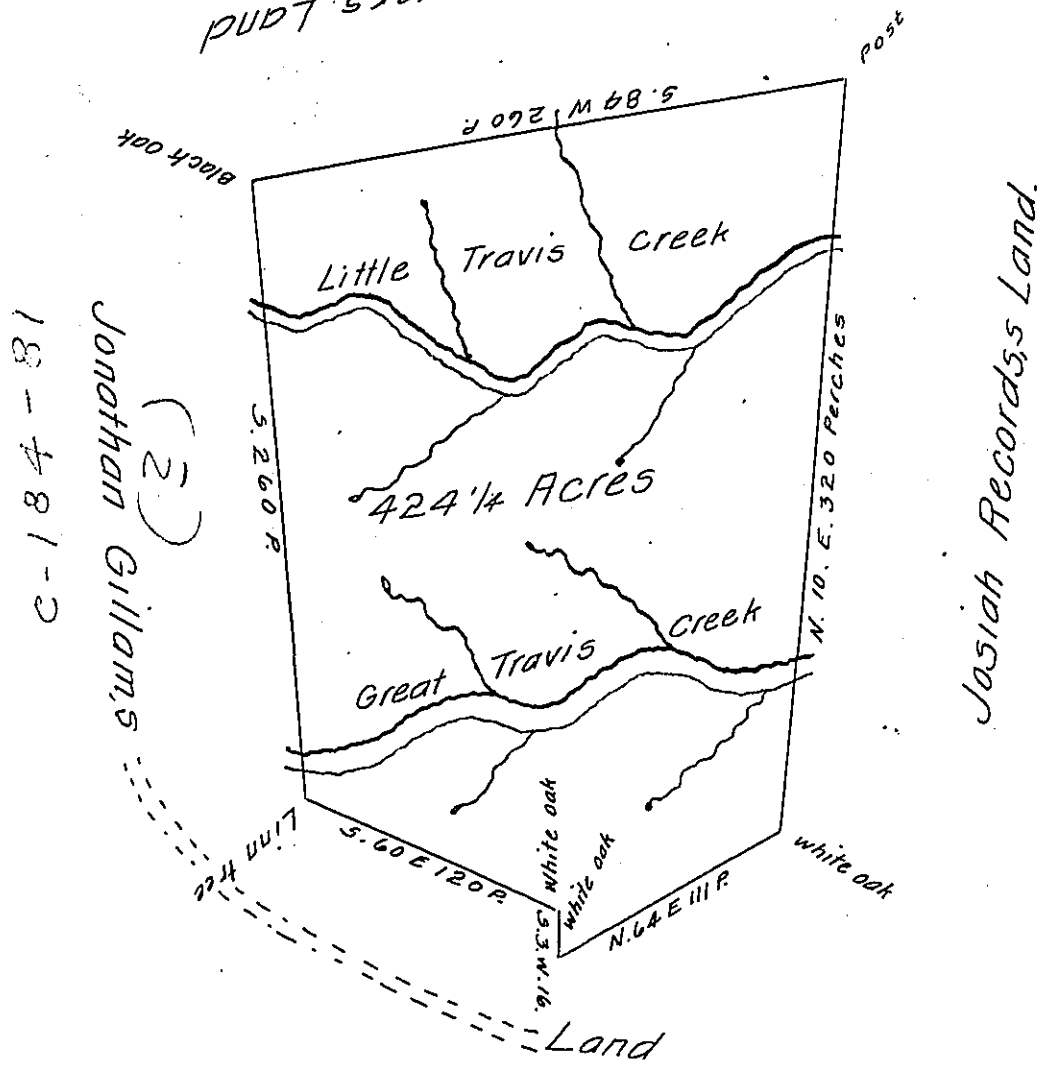

Sampson Beavers Land



The above is a Draught of a Tract of Land Lying on the Waters of Great and Little Travis Creeks. Surveyed for Timothy Rourh April 11th 1786 in Pursuance of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia October 13th 1784. Called the Pleasant Grove. Containing Four hundred and twenty four Acres One Rood. With the allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c.
