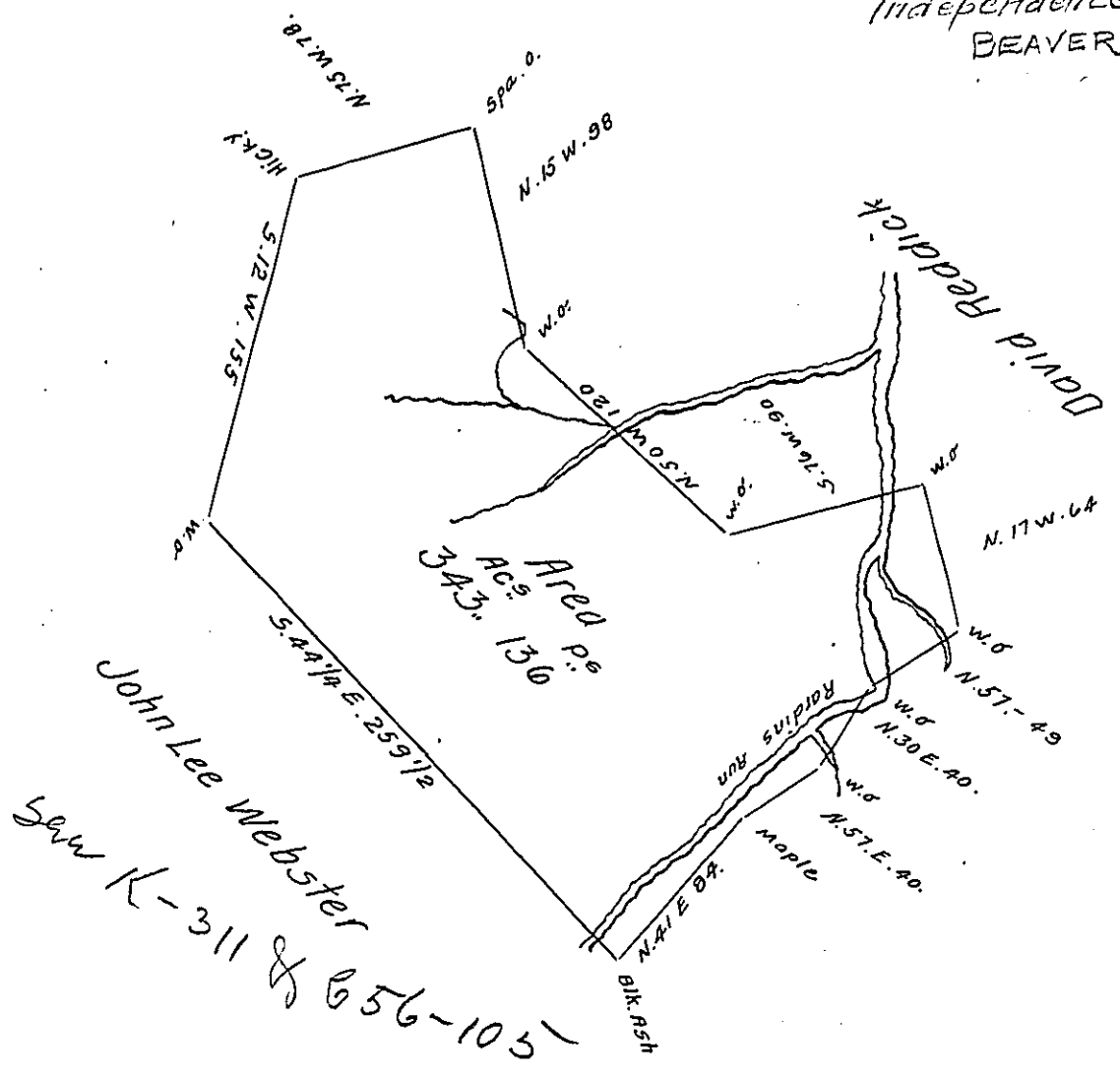

In pursuance of a Warrant Granted Craig Ritchie 28<sup>th</sup> June 1785.
