


FORM NO. 1.



The above is a Draught of a Survey made April 1<sup>st</sup> 1830, for Joseph Dorsey, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Kible for 240 Acres of land dated May 13<sup>th</sup> 1796. Containing two hundred and sixty two Acres, and 105 perches and Allowance of six per cent for highways, situate in East Bethlehem Township, W. County, on the West side of the Monongahela River. Note there is a Ferry, and an old improvement on the above.
