



The Draught of a Survey call'd "Fairview" lying on the Monongahela R. in Washington County. contg 337 Ac^s 134 P^s with the usual Allow^{ce} executed Novem^r 26th 1785. The Survey was first executed on a Warrant in the Name of Jeremiah Proctor for 400 Ac^s dated June 13th 1785 on 5^d Proctor's applying for an Alteration in the Survey. Henry Spears Jun^r produced an Application & Order of Survey in the Name of Nathan Hammon for 300 Ac^s dated Augst 26th 1769. N^o 3768 and requested it sh^d have the Preference of Seniority. The dotted Lines are the bounds of the Survey made on the old order. contg 301 Ac^s 157 P^s with ye Allow^{ce} the whole Draught is agreeable to the Survey made on Jeremiah Proctor's Warrant.
