



The above is a Draught of a Survey made April 26th 1832. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Mary Nelson for ten Acres of land Dated March 22^d 1832. Containing Five Acres and 141 perches & Allowance of Six per Cent for highways. Situate in Cross Creek Township W.C. on the waters of Harman's Creek. being improved at the time of survey but her house is outside of the North line on land which she bought of W^m Criss and which she thought was also vacant but it is covered by a Patent from the Land Office in the name of Benjamin Kannater
