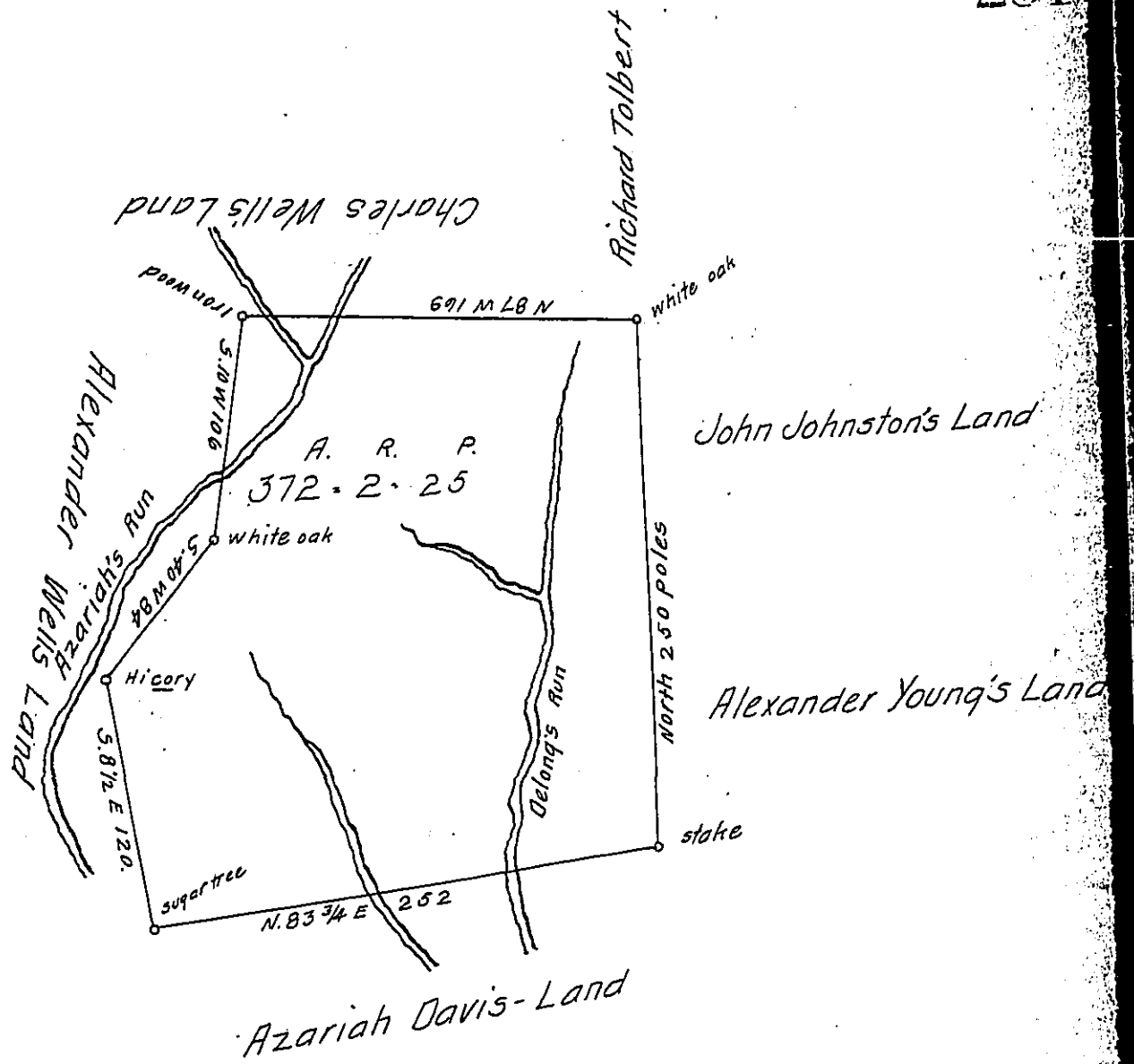


North 250 poles white oak
