


A Draught of a Survey called "The Sheriff's Sale" situate on a Branch of Raccoon Creek in Washington County containing 520 Acs 56 and the usual Allow^{ce} for Roads &c executed Jan^y 15th 1790 in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Benj^o Wells for 400 Acs dated May^y 5th 1785.

Note the Reason this Survey includes so much land is this; it interferes with several Claims and the Board of Property by their order dated ye 7th of Decem^r 1789 directs of Depty. Surv^r to furnish them with a Draught of Wells Claim which is here done leaving it to Mr Wells to explain to the Board his Title to the Surplus.
