



In pursuance of a Law passed 11<sup>th</sup> April 1799 for the selling of Certain Reserved tracts of land therein named the instructions of the late Governor dated 14<sup>th</sup> May 1799 and the Order of the Surveyor General thereupon dated 18<sup>th</sup> May 1799 Surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September <sup>1799</sup> the above described tract of land being Lot No 1 of the Reserved tract Called Warren in (now) Warren County Containing one hundred forty nine Acres & One hundred and thirty six perches strict measure.
